

Rosedale Station - Weekend work during subway closure

Scheduled Dates: October 18 and 19, 2014

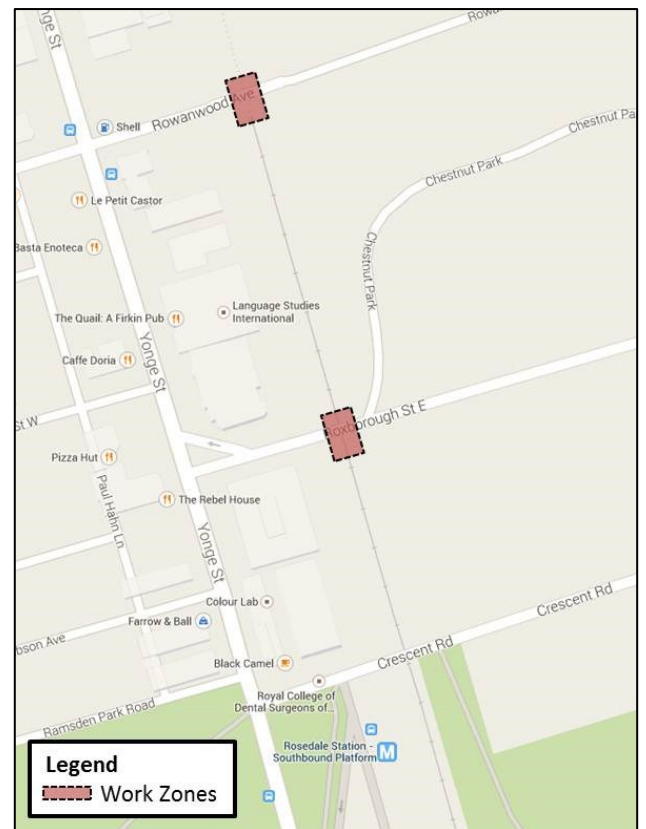

Work Description and Purpose

During the weekend of October 18 and 19, there will be no subway service between Bloor and Eglinton stations in order to carry out a variety of maintenance work. This will include some work north of Rosedale Station.

A crew is tentatively scheduled to remove ballast and gravel (trenches) across the track bed in support of ongoing track maintenance in this area. A high-pressure vacuum system mounted on a truck will be parked **in an area on Rowanwood Avenue and on Roxborough Street East** at separate times. Noise will be evident from the unit when it is in full operation.

The vacuum method used to remove the ballast from the track area is quick and less likely to cause damage to existing underground cabling and possible disruptions to subway service.

Work on October 18 will take place from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m., and 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. on October 19.
